### Highlights of the Program

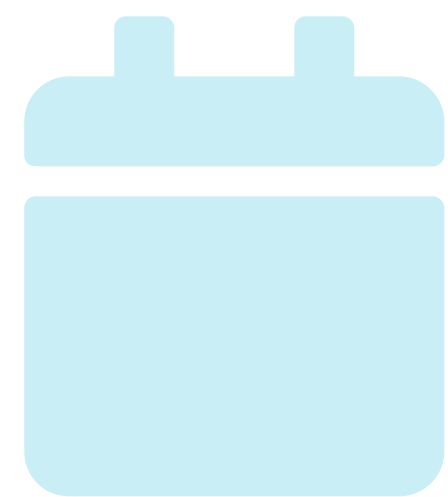
- Speak with different healthcare professionals to learn about the many different options

## Application Requirements

An online application form is required that contains questions about your personal and educational background. Additional requirements can be submitted along with your online application:

- Personal statement
- Resume
- One letter of recommendation
- Transcripts

We will review applications on a rolling basis. We take a holistic look at each applicant, and place great importance on letters of recommendation and your personal statement. The Office of Admissions will schedule individual interviews once your application is completed. We will strive to notify you about the status of your application as soon as possible.
