



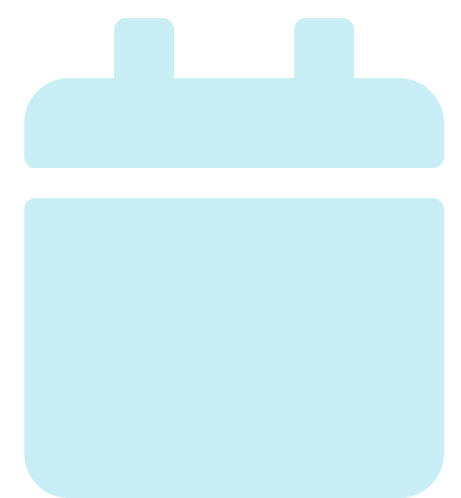
Application Bootcamp

ABC

Application Boot Camp (ABC) is a 5-day interactive workshop designed to assist students in completing their graduate health applications across different disciplines, such as AMCAS, AACOMAS, CASPA, PTCAS, and AADSAS. The program consists of personalized advising along with support in the areas of personal statement, extracurricular activities, school selection, and interview prep.

An online application form is required that contains questions about your personal and educational background. Additional requirements can be submitted along with your online application:

- Personal statement
- Resume
- One letter of recommendation
- Transcripts
